A Georg Jensen .925 sterling brooch, designed by Christian Mohl-Hansen, formed as a bird within a stylized foliate wreath surround, detailed 'Georg Jensen Silversmith Ltd' and '123', import mark London 1947, diameter 4.5cm, together with a pair of matching earclips, post-1945, detailed '66', with folding fittings, diameter of each 2.2cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Brooch: the pin at the back is distorted from its original condition. There are a few scratch marks by the roller clasp. The brooch would benefit from careful cleaning. Otherwise in good condition. Earclips: The earclips are in good condition. Note: the brooch is of hollow construction, the earclips of solid construction. Total weight 28g.

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
