Condition Report

Matching hallmarks and each with matching armorial. Teapot in generally good condition with no significant damage or repair. The engraved armorial is worn and becoming almost indistinct. Few very minor dents to spout. Typical wear and surface scratches. Hinge is good. Handle has been split near top and repaired. Good clear hallmarks. The stand is badly worn, armorial almost completely worn away. Solder repair to rim and foot. Good clear hallmarks.
