## LOT 21

A group of thirteen silver mounted glass scent bottles, including a globular example with hobnail decoration, fitted with a foliate scroll embossed lid and collar, Birmingham 1912 by C.C. May & Sons, height 12.3cm, together with a glass atomizer with plated and apricot enamel collar (some faults).

Estimate: £200 - £300

## Condition Report

Large spiral moulded bottle - crack and bruise to glass body. Silver collar and cover in generally good order with only minor scratches and dents. Atomiser - good condition, few very minor chips/scuffs to edges of glass. 5 cut glass globular bottles - glass in good order, only very minor scuffs/tiny chips. One silver cover has a large dent to top, others with only typical minor dents and wear. All with readable hallmarks. Tall tapered bottle - broken neck and chips. Moulded glass rectangular bottle - broken neck and wrong stopper. Small square tapering bottle - repaired neck and dented silver mount. Squat cut glass body bottle - glass in good condition, only minor scuffs. Silver has some dents and a hole in back of lid. Ovoid bottle with angel mask lid - good condition. Slight wear to silver. Small footed bottle - chip to inside neck, dents to silver and few minor chips/scuffs. Art Deco bottle - minor chips to edges, otherwise good condition.

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
