An early 20th century plated table centrepiece, the circular bowl decorated in relief with scroll filled rectangular panels alternating with vertical beaded bands, the glass liner with fan cut decoration, above four square column supports, on a similarly decorated circular base and flared foot, total height 32cm (chips to rim of glass bowl). Provenance: from the estate of the late John Young (1927-2017).

Estimate: £30 - £50

Condition Report

Overall generally good condition. Glass liner in generally good order but there are a few small/minor chips to the rim, the worse of which is on the two arches. Some light wear to high points on the plate, but generally plate in good order.
