An early 20th century brass four glass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell above a mercury compensated pendulum, the two-piece circular enamel dial with black Roman numerals and Brocot escapement, the case with bevelled glass panels, on a plinth base and bracket feet, height 30.8cm, with winding key.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Overall good condition, no significant damage. Case in generally good condition, typical minor surface scratches and wear. Bevelled glass panels in good order, one has tiny chip to corner but only visible from inside so of little consequence. Dial is good and clean. Pendulum in good order. Currently working but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Also, when the clock is wound it is a little clunky and the strike mechanism is not working, so movement would need some attention.
