A Victorian gold, rose diamond, coral, seed pearl set and pale blue enamelled oval hinged bangle, the front centred by a rose diamond set star motif on an enamelled ground, within a border of alternating corals and seed pearls, on a snap clasp, circa 1880, fitted with a safety chain, inside width 5.7cm.

Condition Report

553. There is a chip to the central blue enamel at one side. There are dents to two of the beads to the side of the centre. There is some tarnishing to the gold work impairing the matt gilding. There is fine scratching at the back of the bangle and a few small dents to the sides. Not hallmarked but looks better than 9ct.
