A pair of Doulton Lambeth stoneware moonflasks, circa 1900, decorated by Joan Honey, monogrammed, with copper lustre fish against a mottled green glazed ground, raised on integral bases, impressed and incised factory marks to bases, height 22.5cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1418 . The flask with the thinner fish has an approx 7mm long by 5mm wide surface glaze chip/bruise to the side, it is not obvious as it blends in with the mottled colouring of the glaze. Otherwise both flasks are in good order with no further damage or restoration. The fish are only on one side of the flasks and are quite wishy-washy /pale with some wear.
