A Poole pottery part wash set, mid-20th century, comprising a bowl, jug and soap dish and cover, decorated by Audrey Heckford, monogrammed, with stylized green flowers against a cream ground, pattern 'IYP', impressed, incised and black painted factory marks to bases, diameter of bowl 32.8cm.

## Condition Report

1437. Jug - typical crazing to glaze, otherwise ok. Bowl - typical crazing to glaze, two starcracks noticeable to the glaze on the bowl exterior which do not go through to the bowl interior and cannot be felt with your nail. Soap dish - typical crazing to glaze, otherwise ok. There is a pierced drainer with the soap dish which should fit on lugs inside the body - it is broken into four pieces though with the remains of an old rivet repair, which is why we have not mentioned it in the cataloguing or photographed it.
