An Art Deco Aynsley bone china butterfly handled part service, each leaf moulded piece with green vertical line detail and butterfly handles and finials, comprising a teapot and cover, a coffee pot and cover, a milk jug, a cream jug, two sugar bowls in two sizes, two teacups and saucers, six coffee cups and saucers and a small plate, green printed factory marks, with red painted pattern No. '1322 W' and black printed retailer's stamp 'Alfred B. Pearce & Co' to bases (minor faults).

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

1425. Coffee pot - fine crazing to cover and parts of pot, ie. spout and rim. Noticeable approx 3cm long hairline to middle of body on one side by some long craze lines. Teapot - glued repair to end of spout. Fine horizontal haircrack to top of foot moving horizontally around body. Milk jug - crazed and with small chip to tip of butterfly handle. Cream jug - light crazing. One teacup - cracked. One coffee cup - painted and glazed over manufacturer's chip to tip of butterfly wing handle. Another with minor random gilt marks to side, a manufacturing issue.
