A Wedgwood Fairyland Lustre Imperial shaped bowl, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, the exterior gilt and enamelled with Woodland Elves III Feather Hat pattern against a green mother-of-pearl ground, the interior with Jumping Faun pattern, gilt printed Portland vase mark to base, diameter 23.3cm.

Condition Report

1458. The bowl has a good nice clear 'ring' to it. There is a minuscule chip to the exterior edge of the footrim, only noticeable on very close inspection. Otherwise there are only very minimal scratches/wear to the bowl overall with generally still good strong gilding. The bowl interior appears a little more 'matt' in appearance in comparison to the exterior. No restoration.

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
