A good 18th century carved boxwood snuff box, finely worked in the form of a shoe with overall armorial decoration, the sole decorated with a two-masted ship and dated 1639, the sliding lid with a bull's head, the sides and front with a stylized flower, bird, leaves and chevron reserve panels, length 10cm.

2431. As a whole the piece is a really rich colour and in good order. There are some old nicks to the edges of the lid and a gouge to the front of the shoe along the bird's wing.
