A Victorian ivory baby's rattle with a pair of pierced ball ends, length 11cm, two Chinese Canton ivory needle cases and a small group of other 19th century ivory and bone items.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

2442. Rattle - one end has been glued at a slight angle and there are some minor chips around the other end. One of the needle cases has a very small chip to the rim of the lid but otherwise ok.

2442. It is impossible to be precise, but at a guess the production of the carving is around 1890.
