A mid-17th century oak six plank coffer, the edges with chip carving, the lid retaining original wire hinges and enclosing a candle box, raised on shaped end supports, height 46cm, width 80cm, depth 35cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

2003. Generally good and original condition with some minor repairs. One small let-in repair on front section of lid. Originally the clasp would have been fitted to the top of the lid and has been moved to the underside. There are later supports added both ends of the lid and to the undersides of the base board. Otherwise a few later nail heads securing the back and typical wear and deterioration to ends of feet.
