A large Royal Worcester porcelain Dragon vase, circa 1887, the ivory ground pear shaped body decorated with scattered gilt enriched floral sprays and entwined with a large relief gilt dragon, inset with green glass eyes, puce printed factory mark including shape number '1081' to base, height 40.5cm (minor chips to relief detail).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1410. One small chip to the spine of the dragon's body, two similar small chips to the bent section of the back left leg and one similar to the front left leg. Very minor chips to jagged edge of mouth, missing one fang totally and part of another. These are all quite minor things and overall we would say the vase is in good order. Very light typical wear to gilding.
