A mid-18th century oak longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the square brass dial with silvered chapter ring, black Roman hours and Arabic minutes, the silvered centre with subsidiary seconds, date aperture and inscribed 'Willm Wainwright, Peterborough No. 1643', cornered by cast and pierced gilt metal mask and scroll spandrels, the hood with glazed door and turned columns above a rectangular trunk door, plain base and bracket feet, height 204cm, with pendulum and two weights (some faults).

Condition Report

1138. The clock is a marriage, case and movement are associated. The case has had numerous alterations, and the base area is in a distressed state. Trunk door mouldings are modern replacements. Movement is sitting on a modern seatboard. It is rather dirty and will require a full overhaul to return to working order. Mechanism appears to be complete apart from missing seconds hand. Has pair of cast iron weights and brass bob pendulum.
