A pair of glass tazze, early 20th century, each shallow circular bowl acid etched within an engraved border, on an hexagonal tapering stem and circular foot, height 12cm, together with a cut glass decanter and stopper, a pair of cut glass decanters and stoppers, and a group of six glass paperweights.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1536. Bruised chipping to the facet edges of the pair of decanters and minor chipping to the bases of their stoppers. The single decanter with small bruises/chipping to the cut detail and a minor nick to the rim. One of the paperweights is cracked, another appears to be a stopper broken off of a base end, another has some little bruises.
