A Dutch double series opaque twist wine glass, late 18th century, the bell bowl with bubble included base engraved with a moth and foliage, raised on a plain stem with four spiral threads outside gauze, on a conical foot, height 14.3cm, together with a group of mostly 19th century glassware, including a triple neck decanter and stopper, a two-handled oval butter dish and domed cover and a boat shaped salt.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1488. Opaque twist wine - small nick to rim exterior and chip to foot. Bladed stem glass - 3 sizeable chips to foot. Small chip to top rim edge. Salt - quite chipped. Butter - glued repair to one handle, number of chips overall. Decanter - extensive small bruised chipping to raised diamond detail. Remainder pretty much ok.
