A mid-19th century Anglo-Indian sadeli ware work table, the hinged lid revealing a compartmentalized and lidded interior, the frieze fitted with a sliding basket holder, raised on shaped end supports united by an octagonal stretcher, the bracket feet raised on ivory spheres, height 73cm, width 61cm, depth 46cm (some faults).
