A Minton bone china cabinet plate, circa 1876, painted by Antonin Boullemier, signed, the centre painted with a classical scene of two kneeling women feeding grapes from a vine to a child within a landscape, within a turquoise and foliate and beaded gilt rim, impressed factory marks to base, diameter 24.2cm.

Condition Report

1450. Overall crazing to glaze. Very faint approx 2cm long hairline amidst crazing visible to rim underside at 7 o'clock, not visible to front. Some light blotchy brown staining to reverse of plate. Tiny blemish to painted scene at 6 o'clock and just by left armpit of maiden's raised arm, quite insignificant things. Overall the gilding and appearance of the plate is good.
