A Derby porcelain part dessert service, early 19th century, each piece decorated with cobalt blue and gilt foliate border, comprising a rectangular tazza, two oval serving dishes and five plates, red painted factory mark to bases, together with eight Brownfield dinner plates, each decorated with a chinoiserie vase within a foliate panel border, impressed factory marks to bases (some faults).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1468. Derby - overall fine crazing to glaze, very light and minor staining. Tazza - minor short hairline to rim by one handle, only noticeable on very close inspection. Oval dishes - one with 5cm long haircrack to rim on underside and 3cm firing crack also only visible to underside. Other with minor chip to footrim and light wear to central gilt detail. Plates - one restored and cracked, one with faint haircrack to rim underside. Brownfield - each in good condition overall with light typical wear.
