A Chinese two-tone agate libation cup, 20th century, the pale grey stone cup formed as a tree trunk, the sides carved and pierced with a reddish pink fruiting peach branch swathed in vapours above lingzhi fungus and rocks, on a green stained and carved ivory and hardwood stand, total height 15cm.
