An early 19th century gold and enameled curved rectangular mourning brooch, the front decorated with a white enameled urn mounted on a plinth forming a glazed hair locket compartment beside a weeping willow, framed by a white and black enamel border with dot decoration, length 3.2cm.

Condition Report

512. There are a few surface marks to the enamel including a chip at 11 o'clock to the border. There is minor wear to the edge of the hair locket compartment. There is no inscription to the back. In overall good condition. Weight 6.9g.

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
