A late Victorian diamond pendant brooch in a circular spiral design, mounted with the principal cushion shaped diamond to the centre, otherwise set with rose cut diamonds, with a diamond set suspension loop, length 3.5cm, principal diamond weight approx 0.45ct, total surround diamond weight approx 0.50ct.

560. Cut: old European cut and old mine cut diamonds. Colour: approx J-K, faint florescence. Clarity: approxSI1-SI2. In good condition commensurate with age. The central diamond has a chip to the girdle. The centre has a threaded hole to take the original detachable pin fitting. The current pin and roller clasp are later. Weight 5.5g.
