A gold and coral pendant necklace, the pendant carved in the form of a seated Buddha, the gold mounts bearing French hallmarks to the base, height 3cm, fitted on a 9ct gold circular link neckchain, spaced at intervals with coral beads, London 1976, length of neckchain 116cm.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

664. Buddha pendant: is of slightly mottled medium to dark colour saturation. There is a hair crack and chip to the head of the Buddha, possibly as a result of fitting the suspension loop. This extends half-way down the body of the Buddha. Height of Buddha including gold mount is 2.8cms. Necklace: there is a hair crack to the principal bead of the necklace above the Buddha's head. Some beads have surface reaching inclusions and slight mottling to the coral. Total weight 49.1g. Diameter of beads approx 6mm ranging to 4mm. One large bead above Buddha approx 8mm. Buddha pendant approx 3cm high by 2.5cm wide. Appear to be all natural and untreated.

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
