A group of Chinese jades, Qing dynasty and later, including a quatrelobed oval dish, the centre carved in high relief with flower and leaf stem, length 17.5cm (one loose ring to handle damaged), with carved hardwood stand, a pale celadon jade archer's ring, length 3.4cm, a mottled black and green jade archer's ring, length 2.7cm, a small celadon jade pot and cover, height 6cm, a white jade figural pendant, height 5.7cm, a mottled green and russet bi (disc), two cylindrical boxes and covers and various carvings of animals.

Condition Report

1098. Oval dish - one ring handle broken and missing small section, otherwise dish is in generally good condition with some typical hairline inclusions but no actual damage. Wood stand in generally good condition with re-glued legs. Pale celadon archers ring - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Spinach green archers ring - good condition, couple of very minor polished out chips to edge. Small celadon jade pot and cover - overall good condition, two hairline inclusions to base of pot and one to rim of cover. Carved hardstone figure - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Two cylindrical boxes - one in good condition. The other with horizontal hairline crack to body. Circular bi disc - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. The metal mount probably needs removing. Dark jade implement - good condition. Jade quail - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Dark jade turtle - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Small jade cat's mask - tiny chips to both ears, otherwise good condition. Jade figural pendant - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Two bird carvings - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Jade Buddhistic lion bead - tiny chip to ear, otherwise good condition. Jade toggle - overall good condition, stone has numerous brown speck inclusions.
