309. There has been a solder repair where the bowl meets the handle, which is fairly obvious when you look at interior of bowl. Otherwise bowl is in good condition with typical light surface wear and scratches. Good clear hallmarks. The silver shaft and turned ebonized handle also in good condition. Total weight 76.9g.
