A George III silver coffee pot of baluster form, the domed hinged lid and knob finial decorated in relief with foliate and fabric festoons, flanked by a beaded and scroll spout and scroll handle, on a similarly decorated circular foot, London 1774, indistinct maker's mark, height 31cm.

Condition Report

396. Knob is pushed down into the dome cover a little bit. Part mark to inner rim of cover. A few dents to the baluster body, particularly to one side, otherwise the definition to the relief work is fairly good. Foot is good and hallmarks clear except maker's mark. No obvious repairs. Weight 775.7g.
