An early Victorian silver castle-top vinaigrette of rectangular form, the hinged lid decorated in relief with a view of York Minster, revealing a pierced and engraved foliate scroll hinged gilt grille, the sides and base with engine turned decoration within raised rims, Birmingham 1842 by Nathaniel Mills, length 4.7cm.

## Condition Report

415. The tower on the far left-hand side of the image has been squashed/damaged. As well as this damage there is some typical light rubbing to high points of decoration. Small dent to rim of underside of box, otherwise rest of the box is in good order. Hinge is good with no repairs. Gilt grille and hinge also in good order.
