A pair of Continental turquoise glazed porcelain figures, late 19th century, one modelled as Cupid, the other of a naked maiden with a bow, each raised on a circular base, heightened in gilt, unmarked, heights 22.5cm and 23cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1419. Cupid - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or repairs. Maiden - small chip to underside of left big toe. Missing bottom end of bow. Glued repair to neck. Some craze lines visible to figure's beak. Otherwise both figures have typical light wear to the gilt detail. The turquoise glaze differs ever so slightly between the two figures.
