A pair of mid-19th century figured mahogany display cabinets, fitted with single glazed doors flanked by bowed glass sides, the interiors fitted with shaped shelves, raised on shaped aprons and block feet, height 161cm, width 96cm, depth 41cm.

Condition Report

2003. General appearance is good, however there are some numerous areas of damage and minor loss to the veneer. One cabinet has a warped section on the top which has made the veneer around the sides crack. Similarly on the other cabinet there is some surface cracks around the top section and the front of the frieze. A few surface cracks around sections of base and a few areas of loss to the plinths.
