A pair of Doulton Lambeth stoneware bottle vases, late 19th century, decorated by Hannah Barlow, monogrammed, each with a frieze of cats in various poses amidst grass on a textured buff ground against a mottled green glazed body, incised and impressed factory marks including '480' and '130' to bases, height 30.5cm (one with chip to rim).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1410. First - chip to upper rim edge (approx 2cm x 0.5cm). Manufacturing fault to glaze on shoulders (approx 1cm x 1cm) and 'drip' to textured ground between 2 cats running vertically, a manufacturing fault. Minor glaze nick to base edge but of no significant. Second - small manufacturers blemish to glaze at base of neck, otherwise ok.
