An English porcelain blue printed and gilt part tea service, early 19th century, possibly Coalport, each piece decorated with chinoiserie scenes of pagodas and rivers, heightened in gilt with foliate border, comprising teapot and cover, slop bowl and eight teacups and saucers, painted '2/116' to bases, together with a similarly decorated teapot and cover and a plate, two pap boats and a tea bowl, decorated with chinoiserie flowers (faults).

Condition Report

1474. Teacups - 4 in good condition, 3 cracked or repaired, one badly stained. All cups with some staining/discolouration particularly to handles. Saucers - 2 in good condition, 6 cracked, repaired or badly stained. Slop bowl - cracked. Cushion teapot - cracked and with matched lid. Circular teapot - badly cracked. Chinese tea bowl - chips to rim. 2 pap boats - in good condition. All gilding with some wear.
