A pair of Chinese Canton famille rose export porcelain vases, mid/late 19th century, painted with opposing figural panels against a ground of birds amidst fruit and flowers, pairs of pink and blue glazed chilong applied to the shoulders beneath Buddhistic lion cub handles, height of vases 35.5cm (one with faults and restoration, converted to lampbases).

Condition Report

1114. Vase 1 - drilled hole to base and some small chips to chilongs on the neck. Otherwise generally good condition. Vase 2 - drilled hole to base, minor chips to chilongs on neck and rim restored. Wood bases also damaged.
