A Victorian gold, emerald and white enameled oval hinged bangle, the front with three starburst shaped motifs, each centred by a step cut emerald within a white enameled ground, otherwise with bead and wirework decoration, fitted with a safety chain, inside width 5.7cm, total emerald weight approx 1.00ct (clasp damaged).

Estimate: £600 - £800

Condition Report

560. Cut: modified square cut emeralds. Colour: bright vivid green. Clarity: emeralds have inclusions visible to the un-aided eye. There are one or two surface reaching inclusions to the emeralds. The tongue of the clasp has broken off and is currently loose. There are a few edge chips to the white enamel. The colour of the gold bloom is uneven. The mounts to hold the safety chain are a later addition. Weight 25.6g.

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
