A Victorian gold, citrine and vari-coloured agate brooch, mounted with the oval cut citrine within a surround of vari-coloured agate, otherwise engraved with Celtic style decoration, probably Scottish, second half of the 19th century, width 6cm.

Condition Report

574. The citrine is of medium colour saturation. The agates are in good condition. There are one or two small shallow dents to the back of the brooch. In generally good condition for the age. Weight 22.9g.

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
