A mid-19th century brass pillar skeleton timepiece with eight day spring driven movement, the circular white enamel chapter ring with black Arabic numerals and inscribed 'Wm. Smith Musselburgh, Maker & Inventor', raised on a main column consisting of six smaller columns through which the steel spring passes, on a stepped marble base with glass dome and pendulum, total height 46.5cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1127. An original William Smith Pillar clock. All parts appear to be there but mechanism is in rather grubby condition. Small fault in back cock, may be a replacement part. Clock is fully wound but it will not run. Minor chips to bottom edge of dome.
