A mid-Victorian burr walnut and ebonized table top stereoscopic viewer with large magnifying lens and canted rectangular base, length 62cm (faults). Provenance: from the estate of the late Nellie Lenson-Smith (1928-2017).

Condition Report

2551. One panel of glass missing to the adjustable hinged end which also has some damage to the veneer and some woodworm damage to the hinge end. Both ends are detached and the large lens end has the viewer adjustment missing. The magnifying lens has some surface scratches. The ebonized plinth section appears to be later made and fitted with the ratchet system to the interior. Otherwise a few minor worm holes and surface marks.
