A late 19th century spelter mantel clock with eight day movement, the dial with enamel hour plaques and blue Roman numerals, the case modelled as a camel and rider, height 44.5cm (faults and lacking pendulum and bell). Provenance: from the estate of the late Nellie Lenson-Smith (1928-2017).

## Condition Report

1133. Overall in fairly poor condition with some missing parts and faults. Also very dirty and with serious cleaning issues. Rider is loose on the camel, his right arm is broken off but present with the lot. Tail of camel broken off and missing and one side of camel's head is missing its headdress decoration. Two holes in base where something must have been attached (maybe a plaque?). Clock mechanism appears to be intact but very dirty with no bell or pendulum. Maker's mark of Japy Freres.
