LOT 1100

A late 19th century French brass gorge cased carriage alarm clock, the eight day movement with grande sonnerie striking on two gongs, alarm and push repeat, the white enamel dial with black Roman hour numerals and Arabic at five minute intervals, above a subsidiary alarm dial, the gorge case with bevelled glass panels and overhead swing handle, three position setting lever to base inscribed 'Clock', 'Silent' and 'Quarters', height 17.5cm.

Estimate: £600 - £800

Condition Report

1100. Overall in generally good condition. Case has typical light surface wear and scratches. No significant damage or repairs. Bevelled glass panels appear to be in good order. Enamel dial has a crack to top left corner, mostly obscured by the case. Not currently running; does tick but does not maintain power after about 15-20 seconds. The strike is working exactly as it should.

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
