Condition Report

1500. One with small chip to gilded edge of one foot and two pinhead sized blemishes to gilding of another foot. Image 1 on our website is the best colour match to the actual vases. There is a white residue around the raised gilt grasses (see image 7 on our website). It seems to clean off. Overall the vases are in good condition. No restoration.
