A pair of French white opaline glass vases, late 19th/early 20th century, each high shouldered body applied with an oval black plaque depicting a male or female classical portrait bust within a jewelled surround and gilded frame, raised on a spreading circular foot beneath a flared neck, black enamelled numerals '20' to bases, height 37.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1484. First - one large chip and smaller nibbled chipping to footrim. Minor decorated over blemish to neck rim edge. Second - small chip to inner rim edge of foot. On both vases the gilding around the edge of the foot, the top of the foot and the base of the neck is completely worn. The remaining gilding to the main bodies is in good order and the gilding to the top rim edges of the necks is lightly worn.
