Schliepstein' and '795' to base, height 16.5cm, together with a Berlin KPM white glazed porcelain figure of Diana and a deer, 20th century, designed by Gerhald Schliepstein, modelled as a reclining female nude beside a deer on an oval base, impressed artist's signature to side of base and printed factory mark to underside of base, height 20.5cm (restoration).
