A Spode Felspar porcelain soup plate, circa 1830, painted with a central floral bouquet within a peach colour ground reserved with three floral panels edged with gilt detail, puce printed factory mark and pattern No. 5062 to base, diameter 25.2cm, together with a mixed group of English porcelain, mostly teawares, including Barr Worcester, Coalport and Derby (faults, restoration and repairs).

Condition Report

1563. Spode Felspar soup plate - small chip to rim underside, some wear. Basket - unmarked. Handle broken in 5 places and visibly restored. Light surface wear and scratches. Derby pastille burner - bowl cracked with light staining. Cover stained and crazed with glued knob. Orange ground jug - unmarked, probably Coalport. 3 plates - generally ok but worn. Davenport Botanical plate - riveted. Peach ground stand - cracked. Unmarked square cake plate - crazed and cracked. Slop bowl - unmarked, probably Coalport, ok. Slop bowl - unmarked grey ground - crazed but ok. Slop bowl - unmarked mid-19th century - chipped and cracked. Sucrier & cover - unclear pattern No. to base and lacking handles. Unmarked square stand & dessert tureen - stand heavily restored, tureen lacking cover and restored. Derby saucer - worn but ok. Unmarked Coalport (?) saucer - crazed but ok. 2 Barr Worcester cups - worn but ok. 2 cups and 3 cans - each with faults/repairs. 3 cups and 1 can - worn but ok. Derby Imari cup and saucer - both with bad faults. Imari egg cup - Derby. Restored. 3 peach ground saucers and 2 cups - crazed with light wear, one cup with haircrack.
