A group of mostly cranberry glassware, late 19th century and later, including two jugs and a basket raised on a knob foot, together with a ruby glass circular bowl, cover and stand, engraved with a hunting scene and fruiting vine borders, and a pair of red over white opaline glass vases, each decorated with foliage and flanked by clear glass and gilt decorated loop handles (some faults).

Condition Report

1437. Ruby glass circular bowl, cover and stand - bowl has numerous small nibbles to the interior of footrim, cover has a small chip and nibble to interior rim, all have some general wear. Red over white opaline vases - one has a 1cm chip to side of rim. Otherwise all in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
