Condition Report

1485. Knobby vases - each with heavy wear to base. Largest - considerably scratches overall particularly above foot, some to middle of body quite deep; 2nd largest - visible scratches to body, again mostly above foot, minor blemishes; Middle vase - internal bruise to base, surface scratches; Smallest vase - number of small digs to surface. Bark vase - ok. Amethyst vase - slightly uneven blemished rim, generally ok.
