A pair of gilt metal mounted French porcelain girandoles, late 19th century, the rectangular plaques painted by E. Bigot, signed, with full length portraits of a Cavalier and Lady of the Court, each against a gilt ground within a stylized floral and geometric border, flanked by a pair of sconces within a beaded edge, unmarked, length of plaques 30cm (one plaque broken in two).

1528. Lady plaque - good condition, no chip, cracks or repairs. Minor scratches to gilt. Metalwork in good order, one nozzle missing. Gallant plaque - porcelain plaque broken in half and in need of repair. Wear and scratches to gilt. Metalwork in generally good order but both nozzles missing.
