## Condition Report

542. Cut: modified square cut sapphires with old mixed cut diamonds. Colour: deep blue sapphires, diamonds are bright and sparkly, faint florescence. Clarity: sapphires are clear to the eye. There is a chip to the red enamel crown. Two of the diamonds have chips to the table facet edges, otherwise in good condition. The box is associated and earlier than the piece. Weight 3.2g.
