## LOT 1459

A large pair of Gien pottery yellow ground vases and covers, last quarter 19th century, the baluster bodies painted in the Oriental style with birds perched on blossom branches to each side, with scattered insects, between cobalt blue lappet borders, flanked by animal head and ring handles, the covers with dog of Fo finials, printed and painted cancelled marks to bases, height 60cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £300 - £500

## **Condition Report**

1459. In good condition overall. One vase with 2.5cm long by 1cm wide chip to edge of foot. There is some minor rubbing/abrasions to the handle and finial extremities, and typical light surface wear/scratches overall. One cover has two chips to the inner rim edge.
