A Gustafsberg Parian porcelain pedestal, late 19th century, of rectangular form, each side decorated in relief with classical figures, within serpent twist and foliate borders, impressed factory marks to top, height 30cm, length 45cm (some faults).

## Condition Report

1547. The fundamental structure of the piece is intact albeit with some long craze/hairlines radiating from the base hole. There are chips (some sizeable) to the base corners and edges and the rim corners and edges. It would appear to be the base to something larger as the top surface edge is where the factory marks are stamped.
