A brass mounted porcelain white glazed table oil lamp base, modelled in the form of a recumbent lion inset with glass eyes, the brass fittings detailed 'Duplex', together with a white opaline shade, total height 42.5cm (converted for electricity). Provenance: from the estate of the late Nellie Lenson-Smith (1928-2017).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1534. Lion - some minor stained craze lines to mane at back of head. Minor and insignificant nick to tuft on top of front right leg at back of figure, to toes of front right paw and to edge of scroll between front paws, all very small and minor. In good order overall. The oil lamp fitting has been converted to electricity with the electric cable coming out the side of it, the porcelain is not drilled. A couple of tiny minute nicks to base edge of shade.
